Community Warden at St. Michael's and All Angels School

CMBC Community Warden, Lee Ackroyd and Heather Stout from the Ovenden Initiative, visited St. Michael and All Angels school to give a talk on the work that Community Wardens do on a daily basis. Lee gave details of what being the eyes and ears of the community involves, including some of the issues he faces such as having to report areas on dog fouling, littering, fly tipping as well as other problems such as uneven paths, fire hazards and antisocial behaviour. He also helps out with crowd control and safety at big events such as the Tour de Yorkshire. As well as all the above, he told the Junior Wardens how he often helps Ward Link Workers with tasks such as door to door walkabouts to ask residents what they think of the area they live in, giving the community a chance to raise any concerns. Lee also explained how he has the right to hand out fines for littering and dog fouling should such a situation arise. The junior Wardens took a keen interest in the session and asked some great questions throughout.

Calderdale College to Launch £1.5m Digi Hub in September 2018

Calderdale College is undertaking a seven-figure project to create a new state-of-the-art Digital and Creative Industries Centre (Digi Hub) in time for September 2018, helping to prepare students for employment in the exciting and fast-developing world of digital and creative industries. The new Digi Hub will see the College invest over £1.5million to create exciting new facilities, including: a Cyber Security Lab, Motion Capture Studio, Games and Web Design Suite, Animation Studio and Digital Media Studio. In addition, it will feature a range of services for businesses, including website and mobile applications, design and commercial print services.

North Halifax Partnership and Andys Man Club in 13 goal thriller

The North Halifax Partnership and Andys Man Club FC went head to head in a charity football match on Sunday 22 April 2018 in memory of former Ovenden Phoenix Player Jordan Sheils and to raise awareness around Mens Mental Health and mark the start of CAP week. The North Halifax Partnership Team eventually ran out 8-5 winners in what was a closely contested affair for most part. After a well worked move between midfield pair Reece Griffiths and former Ovenden Phoenix player Ash Scully the Ball was picked up by North Halifax Partnership Captain and Centre Forward Dan Marham who stayed on his feet following a mistimed challenge in the penalty area before placing a shot into the bottom corner to open the scoring. Andys Man Club F.C. equalized shortly after following a fast counter attack catching the partnership out at the back and with the score tied at 1-1 Ash Scully produced some fantastic footwork in midfield once again before playing a defence splitting pass for Dan Marham to grab his second goal of the game. Friends of West View Park Community Litter Pick

On the morning of Tuesday 24 April, a partnership of 15 people took part in a litter pick in and around West View Park, off Warley Road. Halifax. In 1 hour the group filled 10 bags of rubbish from the park, Warley Road and Trimmingham Lane, in the park a number of used syringes were found and removed by officers from the Calderdale Council. The war memorial to 73 soldiers who fell in the South African or Boer Wars was unveiled in 1904. An elaborate stone structure with bronze tablets, it has a circular upper stage of polished granite supporting a standing bronze figure of a soldier. In 1937, the statue was blown over in a storm. A balustrade from the eastern side of Halifax Town Hall was removed and placed around the memorial sometime in the 20th century. Attempts are being made to access funding for renovation.
