Latest News

Changes to Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs)

Two changes are coming to Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs) which will reduce contractual costs and help manage waste disposal while at the same time ensuring that all Household Waste Recycling Centres remain open and continue to operate their existing hours. From **Monday 3 December**, plasterboard, hardcore and rubble will now only be accepted at Halifax, Brighouse and Todmorden HWRCs, with a charge per bag.

The second change is the introduction of a Resident's permit on a trial basis, to Brighouse and Elland HWRCs, starting on the **Monday 26 November**. Every vehicle visiting Brighouse or Elland HWRC will need a resident permit in order to deposit waste or recycling. Permits will be issued free of charge by the site office, on production of photo identification to prove residence in Calderdale. More information is available [here](#).

St Joseph's Catholic Primary School – Road Safety Campaign Week

Wednesday 21st November saw Community wardens Lee Ackroyd and Zoe Davis attend **St. Joseph's Catholic Primary School** as part of the road safety campaign which involved taking a group of children aged between 5yrs to 8yrs outside the school gates with posters they had designed to deter drivers parking on the school zigzags and lines to make the school a safer place at finishing time and to highlight and educate drivers to the dangers of parking outside schools. Overall it was a success as 8 vehicles were moved off the school zigzags and restricted lines and dozens more parked elsewhere once seeing the children and wardens presence outside the school. Community wardens will continue to work with the school on safer parking with another planned visit in the next few weeks being arranged with Civil Enforcement officers from Apcoa Parking to also attend.



New Defibrillator at St. Columba's Church Hall

On Wednesday 14 November, **St. Columba's Church and Community Hall Group** launched the use of their recently installed Defibrillator in conjunction with a visit from Neil Marsay from the Ambulance Service. Neil held a Defibrillator Awareness Session.

Trish Coyle, Chairman of the Community Hall Group, started the fundraising to purchase the Defibrillator by doing a sponsored slim. Warley Trust and The Danny Jones Defibrillator Fund both gave a grant and Clif by Works (Mohammad) kindly gave a donation. James Haley (A and H Electrical) did the electrical work at a reduced price. James played rugby with the late Danny Jones – Lizzie's late husband. Lizzie's family attend St. Columba's Church.

The defibrillator has been positioned outside St Columba's Church and is registered with the Ambulance Service and available for use for anyone in the area.

Roy Stout has been appointed the Guardian of the Defibrillator and is the contact for the Ambulance Service.
